INITIATIVES

In partnership with CARE International & People in Need, Care Canada is raising funds to distribute urgently needed emergency supplies such as food, water, hygiene kits, and cash to cover daily needs in Ukraine.

The psychological consequences and traumas of the Ukrainian population, already burdened by the ongoing conflict, cannot be under-estimated. For this reason, specialized staff will provide additional psycho-social support for those affected.

People in Need will provide an experienced partner to support the people in Ukraine as best as possible. The organization is one of the largest non-governmental organizations in Eastern Europe and has provided humanitarian aid in the affected regions of Ukraine since the beginning of the conflict in 2014.



Founded in 1945 with the creation of the CARE Package®, CARE is a leading humanitarian organization working around the globe to save lives, defeat poverty, and achieve social justice.
